



**NOTICE OF ELECTION FOR
THE SPECIAL REPORTING TERM FOR
NONCOMMERCIAL EDUCATIONAL WEBCASTERS¹
(Pursuant to Webcaster Settlement Act)
2009-2010 LICENSE PERIOD**

NOTE: Services who have not already paid the 2009 or 2010 minimum fee should submit this Notice of Election along with payment and the Noncommercial Webcaster Minimum Fee Statement of Account form for each year, as applicable.

I. ELECTION

The Licensee identified below hereby elects and declares that it is eligible for the “Special Reporting Term” for the statutory licenses for the making of ephemeral phonorecords and digital audio transmissions of sound recordings² by a Noncommercial Educational Webcaster as set forth in the Federal Register at 74 Fed. Reg. 40614, 40616 (Aug. 12, 2009) (the “Eligible Noncommercial Educational Webcaster Rates and Terms”) and authorized pursuant to the Webcaster Settlement Act of 2009 (Pub. L. No. 110-435; to be codified at 17 U.S.C. § 114(f)(5)). This election is for the period commencing on January 1, 2009, or the date of the Licensee’s first digital audio transmission of a sound recording under statutory license after such date, and ending on December 31, 2010. This election is for any eligible digital transmissions and ephemeral recordings made by an eligible Noncommercial Educational Webcaster on all stations and channels owned and/or operated by the Licensee.

II. REPORTING OPTION

The Noncommercial Educational Webcaster identified below hereby elects the following for the period in which this election is filed.³ (Please check one of the items below.)

Reporting Waiver **Sample-Basis Reports** **Census-Basis Reports**

Noncommercial Educational Webcasters electing the Reporting Waiver option shall pay a \$100 Proxy Fee in lieu of submitting a Report of Use for each of the years 2009 and 2010, as applicable. **This is in addition to the \$500 minimum fee that the Noncommercial Educational Webcaster must pay under the applicable rates and terms.** By electing the Reporting Waiver option, the Licensee further declares and certifies that during the period January 1, 2008 through December 31, 2010, its average monthly usage was and/or is expected to be less than 55,000 aggregate tuning hours (“ATH”). If the Licensee exceeded 55,000 aggregate tuning hours on one or more channels or stations for more than one month during 2009, the Licensee further certifies that it has taken measures reasonably calculated to ensure that it will not make Eligible Transmissions exceeding 55,000 total ATH per month during 2010.

The Proxy Fee **must** be submitted with this Notice of Election, in the form of a (1) check or money order (made out to “SoundExchange, Inc.”) or (2) in a bank wire.⁴
